

APPLICABLE TO ALL DRIVERS

1. Must hold a valid Commercial Drivers License (CDL)
2. Must be at least 23 years of age, and no more than 65 pending health certification by U.S. DOT and TIG approval
3. Must have a minimum 2 years over the road verifiable driving experience in the type of equipment to be insured
4. Must have no major violations within the past 36 months. Refer to the attached list of violations.

DRIVERS WITH THE FOLLOWING ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE

Between the ages of 23 and 25 having

- More than 2 minor moving violations within the past 12 months
- More than 3 minor moving violations within the past 36 months
- An at-fault accident within the last 36 months

Age 25 and over having

- More than 3 minor moving violations within the past 24 months
- More than 4 minor moving violations within the past 36 months
- More than 1 at-fault accident within the past 36 months
- More than 3 minor moving violations in combination with one at-fault accident within the past 36 months

DEFINITION OF MAJOR AND MINOR VIOLATIONS

MAJOR

1. Leaving the scene of accident
2. DUI or DWI
3. Hit and run
4. Reckless driving or conduct
5. Felony with vehicle
6. Racing or dragging
7. Excessive speed >20 miles over posted limit
8. Eluding police
9. Passing a school bus
10. Allowing a DUI or DWI or unlicensed person to drive
11. Driving with suspended, revoked or fraudulent license
12. Failure to report or making a false report of an accident

MINOR

Any moving violation other than as noted above such as:

1. Speeding < 20 miles above posted speed
2. Violation of traffic control device
3. Lane violation
4. Failure to yield
5. Following too close
6. At fault accidents not involving a major violation
